Prep Friends Committee

We welcome volunteers to stand for the Prep Friends' Committee. As the Committee has to volunteer each year, you will not be committing yourselves to the whole of your daughter's time at City. No previous experience is necessary! Committee meetings are held twice each term at school on a Friday morning. Our role is constantly developing and any ideas new parents have are very welcome. You are invited to nominate yourself to volunteer as a Committee member. If you are interested we will contact you with details of our first meeting in the Autumn term. One or both parents are invited to join.

Form / Class Reps

The Form / Class Rep is a very important link between the Prep Friends' Committee and the parents in each class. The role is not onerous. The Form / Class Rep is the central coordinator for the class and we especially encourage them to organise a get together event for the parents in their own class at least once a year. No previous experience is necessary as you will be fully supported by other Prep Form / Class Reps and the wider Prep Friends Committee! Form / Class Reps co-ordinate the Class List and ensure that all families in their class are aware of upcoming activities, events, deadlines, etc... at school. We recommend two parents share this job in order to provide extra support with the new role. If you are interested, please let us know below.
