Our comprehensive programme of higher education events and activities held throughout the girls' time at City helps guide their choices after school. This year, 23% of our students will take up places at Oxbridge, Medical Schools and Ivy League Colleges. We are very pleased that 29% of girls are going on to study STEM subjects (Sciences, Technology, Engineering & Maths) at university.

Other top subject choices this year include Economics, the Arts and Languages, and a number of students are opting to take a gap year and continue with their studies in 2017.

We wish the girls every success in their futures, knowing they have been prepared well for the challenges ahead in their further education and careers.
